

Graduate Admission

Non-Degree or Certificate Program

- Submit transcript showing the award of a bachelor's or a master's degree

Degree Seeking:

- Provide the Admissions Office with copies of official transcripts showing the award of a bachelor's/master's degree from an accredited institution recognized by the Commission on Recognition of Post-Secondary Accreditation.
- **MA/MAT** - 1st time degree seeking master's students- provide official transcripts indicating the last 64 hours of undergraduate/graduate work.

Applicants who have completed an advanced degree from an accredited university must provide official transcripts indicating the last 36 hours of graduate work.

Graduate Record Exam (GRE) is required for those students who have less than a 3.0 GPA but higher than a 2.75 GPA. Students who have less than a 2.75 GPA will be granted non-degree status.

- **MBA** – Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) is required for all Business students whose GPA for the last 64/36 hours of undergraduate/graduate work was less than 3.2.

International Students – (F1) or (J1) student must be degree bound

- Provide above mentioned items
- Submit TOEFL scores 550 paper based test or 79 internet based test
- Provide Financial Statement showing adequate funds and Health Form
- Submit transcripts must be translated in English and evaluated by a NACES member

Final admission into the student's particular degree objective will be determined by the department.
