

Information Required of all International Graduate Students

- 1) **Application for Admission**
- 2) **Student Health Form**- signed and returned by prospective student's physician
- 3) **Student Financial Statement**- signed and returned by prospective student's bank and with accompanying bank statement
- 4) **Official college transcripts**- translated into English and that have been evaluated by an Independent Evaluation Service (NACES affiliate) if undergraduate degree was obtained outside the United States. A list of approved NACES members is provided.
- 5) **Official GRE or GMAT scores**- if last 64 hours of undergraduate credit is determined by Independent Evaluation Service to be below 3.0 or 3.2 respectively.
- 6) **Official TOEFL Scores**
 - iBT= 79 (internet- based test)
 - pBT= 550 (paper- based test)

All supporting materials, including national examination scores and/or transcripts from colleges or universities (with an English translation); all test scores, including the TOEFL; proof of adequate financial support; and health examination form must be on file in the Admissions Office by:

April 1 Summer semester
July 1 Fall semester
September 1. Spring semester
