

Information Required of all  
International Undergraduate Students

**1) Application for Admission**

**2) Student Health Form-** signed and returned by prospective student's physician

**3) Student Financial Statement-** signed and returned by prospective student's bank and with accompanying bank statement

**4) Official high school transcripts-** translated into English and that have a cross reference chart converting the number grade ranges into letter grades generally used in the United States. For example some systems use the following: A= 13-15; B=10-12; C=7-9; D=4-6; F= 0-3

**5) Official SAT or ACT scores-** Critical reading, Math and Writing scores should be 500 or greater for the SAT or ACT sub-scores for English, Math, and Reading should be 21 or greater.

**6) Official TOEFL Scores**

iBT= 79 (internet- based test)

pBT= 550 (paper- based test)

All supporting materials, including national examination scores and/or transcripts from colleges or universities (with an English translation); all test scores, including the TOEFL; proof of adequate financial support; and health examination form must be on file in the Admissions Office by:

April 1 ..... Summer semester  
July 1 ..... Fall semester  
September 1.....Spring semester
