

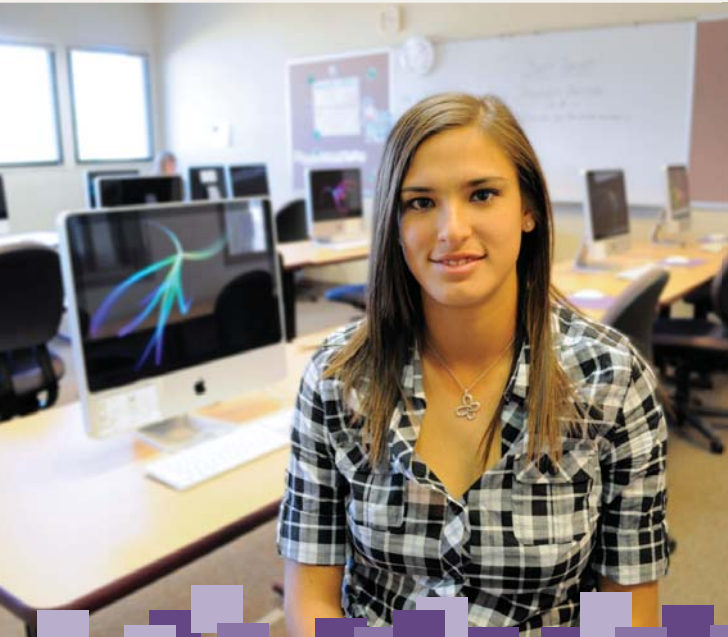

The WUE program lowers tuition for students from AK, AZ, CA, CO, HI, ID, MT, NV, ND, OR, SD, UT, WA and WY. Resident tuition waivers are available to students in Arizona, Colorado and El Paso, TX.

WNMU partners with universities and community colleges throughout the region. Transferring credits and/or degree programs is easy.
