COURSE OBJECTIVES:

The course is specifically designed for prospective or already practicing bilingual teachers and is meant to provide a means for increasing vocabulary in Spanish in order to be able to teach different subject areas in the language. Students will be exposed to terminology in Spanish which is used in education, psychology, science, mathematics, language arts, social studies, health, art and music. Although it is not to be considered a methods course, bilingual methods for teaching the different content areas will be covered in order to expose the students to the corresponding terminology in Spanish. The course will be conducted in Spanish and students are expected to use formal Spanish in discussions and in their written work. Students who do not intend to be teachers may also increase their vocabulary in other areas of interest.

METHODS AND REQUIREMENTS:

The textbook Spanish for Teachers will be used as a basis for class discussion and role playing. Students will be expected to complete the exercises at the end of the each

chapter in order to prepare for vocabulary quizzes. The instructor will also give lessons in math, science, social studies, language arts and other subjects in order to introduce vocabulary which pertains to those subjects. Final grades will be based on the following:
