

CAREER SERVICES/CO-OP ACTIVITY – 2008-2009

Career Services completed Fall 2007 and Spring 2008 surveys and will conduct survey of Summer 2008 and Fall 2008 graduates in June 2009.

Director served on planning committee for and hosted the 4th Annual Academic/Research Symposium and Career Fair held May 5, 2009. This year attendees were asked to register as they arrived for the event with 200 signing in (actual number most likely exceeded that number as not all signed in). Twenty employers paid a fee to participate in the Career Fair, generating \$800 revenue for Career Services and realizing approximately \$400 after expenses. The New Mexico Department of Workforce Solutions partnered with Career Services in putting on this event and shared in some of the expenses.

The two conferences attended by Director of Career Services were the NACE (National Association of Colleges & Employers) National Conference in New Orleans in June 2008 and the (NMCDA) New Mexico Career Development Association in Albuquerque in March 2009.

Director also presented “Minute Clinics” at the March 2009 meeting of the New Mexico Consortium of Career Educator and Employers (NMC²E²) in Albuquerque. Travel expenses for the meeting and NMCDA Conference were covered by the Consortium.

Career Services information was presented to approximately 250 students through “Minute Clinics” held throughout campus during the fall and spring semesters, resulting in 75 students visiting Career Services for follow-up visits.

Director assisted with Resident Assistants’ program presented at the RAppin Conference in Grand Junction, CO.
