Silver City, NM – Two solar courses are being offered at Western New Mexico University beginning March 28 and April 25.

Solar Photovoltaic and Solar Photo Hydronics are four-week courses administered by the School of Applied Technology. Students completing these courses will be administered the National Basic Photovoltaic Certification Examination.

Selected students will have tuition, books and examination fees waived for participation in the course. Applicants who are selected will be required to complete both courses. Upon completion, three credit hours will be earned for each course.
