Applications are invited for the following anticipated opening: a nine month, tenure track faculty position to start in **January 2012**. The successful candidate is required to be involved in advising, university committees, program development, assessment, university service, scholarly activity, and community service as appropriate. All finalists will be expected to make a thirty-minute (30) presentation in an actual classroom situation at the time of the interview. The topic will be the choice of the screening committee. Interest in research, publications, and securing grants; experience on university committees or related community organizations; participation in state/national professional organizations; previous teaching experience in higher education, and past successful K-12 teaching with groups from diverse backgrounds, is required. There is an opportunity to develop a new and creative masters program for teachers.

Silver City – Seeks an Assistant Professor, Educational Generalist, 9 month, tenure-track position. **Minimum Qualifications:** Must hold an advanced education degree (will consider ABD for Assistant position). Must have at least four years K-12 public school teaching experience. Must have experience working with diverse student populations and a commitment to collaboration as a member of a diverse faculty team. Must have the ability to teach in three of the following areas: assessment, classroom management, history and philosophy of education, and technology. Must be authorized to work in the U.S. Preferred Qualifications: Experience in an NCATE teacher education/teacher training program is preferred. Experience with Hispanic populations in a rural setting is preferred. NM teaching certification is preferred. Proficiency in Spanish is preferred. Experience teaching web-based courses is preferred. Preference will also be given for experience in multicultural education and past higher education collaborations with public schools. The NCATE accredited SOE is the largest academic unit at WNMU. **Salary Range: \$52,845 – \$54,755**
