**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:** Under general supervision, performs a variety of journey level activities to prepare and apply surface finishes to protect and/or decorate interiors and exteriors of buildings, facilities, and property. Prepares surfaces of exteriors and interiors of the University's buildings and facilities, removes peeled and/or flaked paint and varnishes; patches and repairs concrete, sheet rock, and other surfaces; applies tape and texture to sheet rock; estimates material and time required to complete required job; selects and mixes paint in accordance with formula to match surrounding surface color. Applies paint, varnish, stains, enamel, or lacquer to decorate and protect interior structures, fixtures, and/or furniture; applies paint to exterior surfaces and trims of masonry and wood structures to protect and preserve surfaces; applies varnish to wooden structures and property; assigns and monitors work performance of assigned Trades Assistants and/or student workers to ensure compliance with safety and quality standards. This position is part of a collective bargaining unit upon completion of the 90 day trial period; and performs other duties as assigned by management.

**MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:** High School Diploma or GED equivalent with six months experience in painting.

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:** Completion of a vocational/trade school course or program in painting. Experience working with diverse groups and Proficiency in Spanish.

**LICENSES/CERTIFICATIONS REQUIRED:** Provide proof of a valid Driver's License in good standing, including a DMV record of history and current status, upon offer of employment. WNMU Defensive Driver's Certification must be obtained prior to use of a University vehicle.
